



Instructions for login into CAS and LMS Moodle

Login into CAS

Before you start working in LMS Moodle, you have to check and enter the following data at the website

(<https://ldapuser.cuni.cz/>) Central Authentication Service (CAS):

- **User name:**
 - See your student card
 - Is given to you upon your registration and is used to login to the Student Information System (SIS)
<https://is.cuni.cz/studium/eng/index.php>
- **Password:**
 - Is the same as for SIS
 - **The temporary password** which you received upon your registration (at the beginning of the 1st year) **is to be changed** before you start working in LMS Moodle

CAS - Charles University Authentication Service



Entering and verifying (validating) email address

- Your email address has to be entered and verified (validated)
- **It is not possible to work in LMS Moodle if your email address has not been added in the CAS**
- You might need to try to verify the email address several times
- You can experience some problems while validating your email address if using Hotmail.com domain; gmail.com domain has less problems while verifying (validating) your email address
- If you are using gmail.com or other domain with a calendar you always need to set up the correct time zone within your calendar

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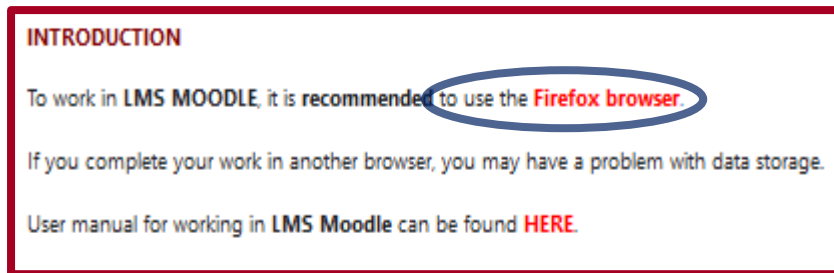

- LMS Moodle is optimized for the **Mozilla Firefox** web browser



- Download of the **Mozilla Firefox** web browser is **for free**. The direct download link is to be found among the introductory information of the course

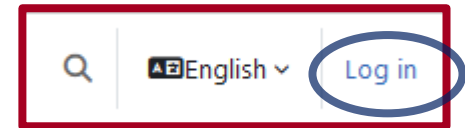


- There might be problems while attempting to **save/store your results/activities** if using a **different browser**
